MixTalent Students 12 and 15 plus are assistants to the Mayors in Europe. **They are the MixTalent Web Youth Council.**


They complete the sentence:




Our MixTalent Expo is Multi Lingual: English, Dutch, French, German. As well students 12 & 15plus as students 6 & 9plus have an own place and task

After we made this drawing in the weblessons, we have discussed the meaning of this quotation by email and in the chat.


Comments by Students – it is about:
